Police – Autumnfest weekend went well. There were 14 complaints and 1 arrest. Candy drop at the park went well there were about 70 kids.


DPW – Completed metal testing. Finishing fall work at the cemetery. Poured the strip and still need to install the drain. Autumnfest weekend was good.
