The Village of Elkton continues to be a great place to live, work, and play. The Elkton Community Walking Path will be completed in the Spring of 2024. A ribbon cutting ceremony and community event will be held at that time. The path is located in Ackerman Park. Please remember this is a non-motorized path for walking and biking only. Also, please be a respectful pet owner and clean up after your pet when utilizing any public space.

Many civic organizations plan events throughout the year in Elkton. The Elkton Community Happenings Facebook page is a great way to stay connected to all the events in Elkton. Upcoming events for Fall and Halloween can be found on social media and in the newspaper.

Monthly meetings of the Elkton Village Council are held on the second Tuesday of every month at 6:30P.M. All committee meetings are posted on the front door and in the Clerk/Treasurer's office. Public input is welcome at all meetings. You may also email the Clerk's office at elktonclerk@comcast.net with any comments or call (989) 375-2270. Clerk's office hours are Monday – Friday 7:30 A.M. until 4:00 P.M.

Weekly trash pickup is on Wednesday, unless a holiday falls on Monday. Then trash pickup is moved to Thursday. Trash, yard waste, and recycling bins should be placed at the curb by 6:00am on Wednesday. Trash must not be put to the curb prior to the day before trash pickup and empty cans must be brought back off the curb no later than the day after trash pickup. If you have large items, carpeting, etc. you want picked up you must call (810) 667-4885 for special arrangements. Yard waste pickup will end on November 29th, 2023 and resumes on April 3rd, 2024.

2024 is a Presidential Election Year. Please watch for the Primary and Regular Election dates and early voting locations, as many election laws have been updated or changed. Please verify your voter registration location, especially if you have recently moved.

M.** As we transition into winter, please remember to clear sidewalks of snow and ice, particularly in the business areas. Please remind your snow plowing company to not block sidewalks with snow piles when clearing your driveway. For your safety, several security cameras have been installed at Ackerman Park, downtown, and the Pocket Park. With these cameras, comes free public Wi-Fi for you to enjoy at the parks.
