

## Economic Vitality Incentive Program/County Incentive Program Certification of Consolidation of Services

Issued under authority of 2012 Public Act 200. Filing is mandatory to qualify for payments.

Each city/village/township/county applying for Consolidation of Services payments must:

1. Certify to the Michigan Department of Treasury (Treasury) that the local unit listed below has produced and made readily available to the public, a consolidation plan as required by 2012 Public Act 200. The plan shall be made available for public viewing in the clerk's office or posted on a publicly accessible Internet site.
2. Submit to Treasury a consolidation plan.

**City/village/township:** This certification, along with a consolidation plan, **must be received by February 1, 2013** to receive the February and April payments or on or before March 31, 2013 to receive the April payment. Post mark dates will not be considered. For questions, call (517) 373-2697.


**County:** This certification, along with a consolidation plan, **must be received by February 1, 2013** (or the first day of a payment month) in order to qualify for that month's payment. Post mark dates will not be considered. For questions, call (517) 373-2697.

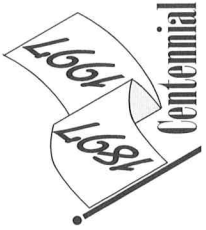

## Previous Years Consolidation Proposal

The Village of Elkton's previously proposal:

1. Sharing a street sweeper with Pigeon  
The Village of Elkton ended up not doing the sharing of the street sweeper. It was not feasible to do so. The added expense of gas to drive it back and forth and the fact that we couldn't get a schedule together so that it would work out for both villages. So it didn't work out.





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## Consolidation of Services

The Village of Elkton current shared services:

1. There is an agreement in place between the Village of Elkton and Oliver Township that they would house our ambulance in their fire hall and we would store the lecture equipment and have the elections in our village hall.
2. The Village of Elkton plows the snow from in front of the Oliver Township Fire Hall at no expense to the township as well as provides water to the fire department for fire at no expense to the township
3. The Village of Elkton pays for the insurance on the Historical buildings in our park for the Historical Society and they approve them to put historical buildings in the park as well. This past year it was approve for an old fashioned style windmill and an outhouse.
4. The Village of Elkton also provides insurance for our Elkton Area Youth Center. We gave the board a lease on the building and don't charge them rent and we carry the insurance. This building is for the children to use for recreation and the boy scouts meet there as well.

The Village of Elkton's ideas to increase cooperation, collaboration and consolidation of services:

1. Oliver Township has requested the village to look into the cost of us doing their payroll for them. This would be an expense to the Township but not to the village. If the township agrees with the proposal it would start at the beginning of their fiscal year.
