Department Reports

Clerk-Phyllis Baranski read a thank you note from a family assisted by the Elkton Ambulance.

Ambulance-Coordinator Beth Swartzendruber-March had 31 runs. The County is now keeping track of the number of runs that Ambulance services are called to respond out of their normal service area. Elkton Ambulance had 14 runs between Jan. 1st and March 20th this year outside the normal service area. Stephanie Bradley is the only student attending the EMT class at Scheurer for the Elkton Ambulance. There is a MFR class starting in Pigeon. Beth will get all the information to Agnes Kosinski to be placed on the Elkton Community Happenings Facebook Page.

DPW-Superintendent Lonnie Schulz: The railings on the gazebo are being replaced and painted. The lagoon discharge will take place this month. The Maude St. project should begin at the end of this month or beginning of May. The East Well will have the draw down testing done this month. This was a budgeted item. The street sweeper will be brought out soon.

Police-Chief Scott Jobes: There have been 183 complaints so far this year. Chief Jobes is working on Ordinance violations, such as inoperable vehicles.

Committee Reports- Agnes Kosinski reminded people that Hoffman Street will be blocked off on Saturday April 13th in the morning for the Frankenmuth Credit Union Spring Fling. Agnes Kosinski announced that Elkton has been chosen for the Comcast Cares Day on Saturday April 27th. Comcast employees and local volunteers will work from 7:30a.m.-12:30p.m. The location will be at Ackerman Park. The volunteers will work indoors at the Civic Center if there is inclement weather. Agnes would like to see as many community volunteers as possible. The more volunteers there are, the larger the donation the Elkton Lions Parks & Rec committee will receive from Comcast.

Public Comment: Melissa Parrish stated there is still another One Way sign in the alley that needs to be removed.
