President Randy Haley called the Special Meeting to order at 7:00 P. M. with the Pledge of Allegiance. Trustees present: Jeff Zarnke, Bridgette McCarty, John Ginter, Martin Baker, Agnes Kosinski, and Gail Brown.

Randy Haley explained he called this special meeting for a wage negotiation regarding Adam Csanyi, Patrol Officer. Martin Baker then offered Adam Csanyi a closed session. Adam Csanyi did not want a closed session. Randy asked Adam to explain his situation to the Council.

Adam Csanyi is requesting a bump in pay, as he has another job opportunity in the local area that is offering a \$2 increase in his hourly wage. Discussion regarding wages of all employees being lower than other municipalities around the county. Randy Haley gave the Trustees a benefit analysis sheet regarding how much benefits to employees cost per hour. Discussion regarding health insurance costs increasing for the upcoming renewal period. Finance just met on Monday to hear about the health insurance options. Labor Relations has not had an opportunity to review the options as of yet. Finance has not met regarding the upcoming budget as of yet. Discussion that Adam Csanyi would need an answer regarding the hourly wage increase very soon, even if it didn't take effect until the upcoming budget year.

Motion Randy Haley, second Jeff Zarnke to refer the increase in wage request to Labor Relations Committee.
