President Dan Armbruster called the Public Hearing of the Elkton Village Council to order at 6:30 P. M. Trustees present: Bridgette McCarty, Chris Parrish, Agnes Kosinski, Deena Jobes, and Craig Genow. Excused Absent: Gail Schember.

Dan Armbruster stated this public hearing is to receive input from the public regarding the Walking Path Grant. The proposed walking path would be in Ackerman Park and would be partially funded through a MDNR Grant. Dan Armbruster discussed the proposed map of the path and the budget for construction. Dan Armbruster then asked for any public comment. Fred Santos, Elkton Village Resident, is in support of the walking path and discussed the idea of extending the path along the river to the East, if the land owner would work out a deal with the Village sometime in the future. Discussion on the extension idea of the path. Phyllis Baranski, Village Clerk/Treasurer, stated the Village has received about 10 or 12 letters of support from civic organizations, businesses, and churches. These letters were requested from them to be included in the grant application. Dan Armbruster stated the next step in the grant process is to adopt a Resolution to also be included in the grant application. Seeing no further public input or discussion, President Dan Armbruster called for a motion to adjourn the Public Hearing.
